Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How long is each course?

A: From August 28 - through the date of the AP exam for that class

Q: What kind of time commitment is required?

A: Roughly 10-15 hours per week

Q: How often will the class meet online? Are there designated times to participate online?

A: A unit syllabus with assignments will be posted at the start of each topic. Students should check back on their Schoology page daily for updates, do-nows and This Day in History. There will be occasional review Google Hangouts that are live, but otherwise, there are not designated times to participate online.

Q: What are the prerequisites for taking a course?

A: There are no prerequisites but there are recommendations for grade level.

Q: Do I need to purchase course materials?

A: Yes, students are to purchase the required text, review material and if assigned, primary source reader

Q: Are the courses graded?

A: The Instructor will be giving detailed feedback on all assignments and at the end of the course will issue an informal transcript of the course and grade

Q: Can I earn a degree or credit toward a degree from this course?

A: At the conclusion of the course, students will take the national AP Exam, issued by the College Board. College credit is typically given for a passing score of a “3” or higher, depending on the institution

Q: What is your refund policy?

A: If a student drops the class and we receive written notification within 14 days of the start of the school year (Aug. 28th), a full refund, minus a 5% administrative fee will be issued. A 50% refund will be issued if a student withdraws from the class and we receive written notification within 30 days of the start of the school year. No refunds will be issued after 30 days. Q: How do I register for an online course?

A: Please click ‘purchase’ for the course you select on our NoahNation website. Once we receive payment, you will receive an email with the agreement and course information.

Q: If my course does not begin for several weeks, do I need to enroll now?

A: Technically no, but space is limited and we are offering an early bird special!

Q: Do I need any special computer equipment in order to take an online course?

A: You need a fast internet connection as you will likely be viewing some videos. You also need to have a word processing application (preferably Microsoft Word), and account with Google for use of Google Drive and a (free) account with Schoology
